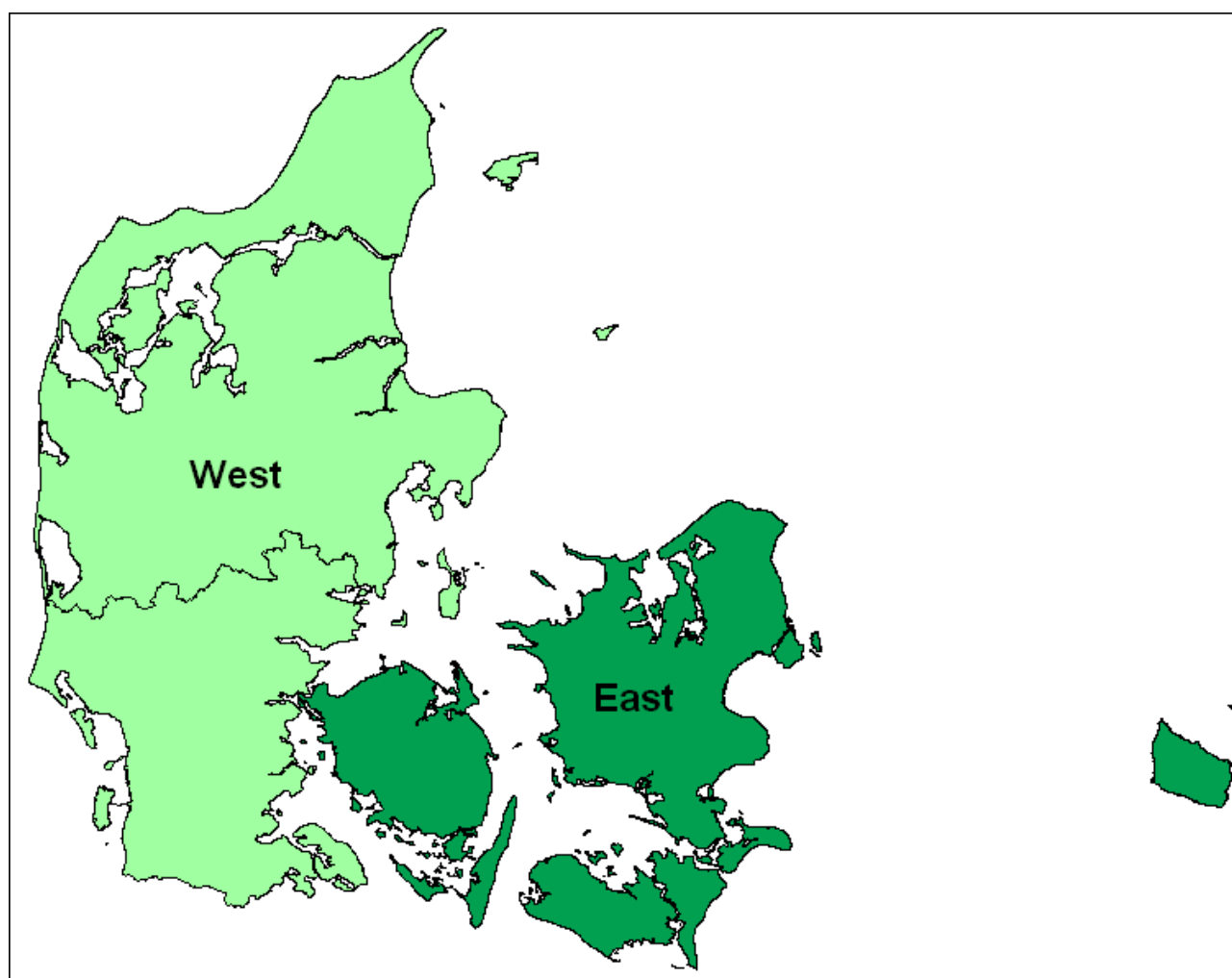

5) Porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS) is endemic in Denmark.

6) Plasmacytosis occurs in the northern part of Jutland, where it is subject to an eradication program.

7) Infectious pancreatic necrosis (IPN) is endemic in Denmark, but approximately 50 fish farms are officially certified as IPN-free.

8) Bacterial kidney disease (BKD) is endemic in Denmark, but approximately 30 fish farms are officially certified as BKD-free.

Number of outbreaks in March 2010

The table presents outbreaks of diseases, which are notifiable in Denmark (except the diseases leptospirosis, salmonellosis, caprine arthritis/encephalitis, maedi-visna, PRRS, plasmacytosis, infectious pancreatic necrosis and bacterial kidney disease). In the table is an outbreak per definition one infected herd/flock.
